The Space Center Houston is related to the exciting future and remarkable past of America’s human space flight and exploration. It features more than 400 space artifacts, permanent and traveling exhibits, and theaters. The goal in developing this facility was to provide a center that appeals on an emotional level as well as an intellectual one to engage adults and children alike – a Center that reaches guests' minds through their hearts. The hands-on activities, films,

exhibits and live shows do just that. Space Center Houston has the world’s largest collection of moon rocks and lunar samples for public view. It is home of NASA Mission Control, International Space Station Mission Control and astronaut training. It is the home of the international landmark Independence Plaza – the only place in the world where you can enter a space shuttle replica resting on top of the original shuttle carrier aircraft, NASA 905. You will be immersed in the science and history of the shuttle era and have a rare glimpse into the ingenuity, breakthroughs and technological advances which impacted the future of exploration.
