Eastern Nebraska Research, Extension and Education Center (ENREEC) Tour In-Field Research, Teaching, and Nebraska Ag

Date: Monday, July 10, 2020 – 2:00 PM – 6:00 PM

The 9,600-acre University of Nebraska Eastern Nebraska Research and Extension Center (ENREEC) near Mead, NE is one of the most unique research, extension, and education facilities in the United States. We will take a look at ongoing, long-term, and in-the-field research and education at ENREEC. The ENREEC visit includes a walk through the Crop Management Diagnostic Clinic plots used for hands-on training for agri-professionals. See a live demonstration of a hail machine that simulates damage. Learn about research, education, and training to mitigate the devastating impact of hard



rain and hail and learn how the University of Nebraska is working with producers to track the devastating Soy Gall Midge and the research that is being conducted. Learn about the University of Nebraska's research in sensor-based Nitrogen management, including fertigation. Learn about the research and how Nebraska Extension is working directly with producers in conducting research trials on their own fields focusing on improving the efficiency of nitrogen fertilizer use through PROJECT SENSE (Sensors for Efficient Nitrogen Use and Stewardship of the Environment). This tour also includes the opportunity to see and learn about the long-running carbon sequestration research project and hear about the findings from both dryland and irrigated cropping systems. ENREEC tours provide the opportunity for informal interaction with the people who are working directly with innovative research and the opportunity to learn about the projects and technology up-close.



Tour Requirements: Participants must be above age of 18 years old, able to take walking tours and manage stairs, wear closed toe shoes, no shorts, no back packs are permitted at company sites (you can leave bags on bus), all tour attendees are responsible for their personal property. While on tour, taking pictures taking is not allowed except as host permits.

Cost: \$35 - Includes roundtrip transportation between CHI Convention Center and ENREEC.
